Mr. DeGuzman passed away on Friday, Dec 05, 2008 at his home. He was born on Jul 17, 1917 in Phillipines to Roman and Francisca (Aranda) DeGuzman. He attended school in the Phillipines. After high school he began working for the Phillipine government. He went to Gwam and worked as an airplane mechanic. He then met Estefania Taroma and married her on Dec. 22, 1954 in the Phillipines. In 1968 he began working with the department of Defense and the US Navy until he retired at age 60. He and his wife moved to the US in 1993. He was a member of the Gorilla movment in the Phillipines against the Japaneses invasion.
