Princeton - Anthony Francis Carr of Princeton, Illinois, died Sunday, January 31, 2021, at his home.

He was born August 1, 1975, in Mendota, Illinois. Tony attended schools in Mendota and

Princeton, graduating from Princeton High School in 1994. He attended Sauk Valley

Community College and earned an Associate's Degree in Heating, Refrigeration, and Air

Conditioning. Through an apprenticeship, he became a licensed plumber. His craft then evolved to pipefitting. Tony's career allowed him to create lifelong friendships as he worked for Whitlock Plumbing and Heating, Triple Service, Plumbers and Pipefitters Local 422, and finally Pipefitters Local 597. Tony was dedicated to supporting his children's interests. He enjoyed spending time with his family and friends outdoors, especially snowmobiling, boating, hunting and fishing.
