



## Augustina F. Ernat

October 1, 1916 - May 30, 2008

PRINCETON — Augustina F. Ernat, 91, of Princeton died Friday, May 30, 2008.

Born Oct. 1, 1916, in Granville to Stanley and Marie (Nowak) Molinoski, she married Michael R. Ernat Feb. 3, 1940. He died Feb. 9, 1997.

Prior to her marriage, she worked in the Spring Valley Garment Factory. She and her husband farmed in the Hennepin area for 25 years before moving to Princeton in 1966.
