Mr. Schultz passed away on Sunday, Jun 27, 2010 at Perry Memorial Hospital. He was born on Jun 30, 1920 in Bureau Twp., IL to William and Ellen (Ruberg) Schultz. He attended Princeton High School. He was a life-long farmer and was the Director of the First State Bank of Princeton. He was on the ASCS County Committee. He served on the Soil and Water Conservation Board, he was president of Berlin Mutual Insurance Co, Supervisor of Arispie Township, and was a 4-H leader. He was a 50 year Mason, in the Elks, and the Moose. He showed ponies for over 75 years, starting when he was six years old. He was the Superintendent of Ponies for the Bureau County Fair. He served in the US Army for five years during WWII as a Staff Sergeant in the Pacific Theatre. He married Suzanne Coll on Jan 18, 1948 in First Presbyterian Church in Princeton. She survives. He was an active member of Presbyterian Church.

He survived by his wife of 62 years Suzanne of Princeton and his four children Kathy Costerisan of Princeton, Mark (Debra) Schultz of Princeton, Sarah (Dan) Waggoner of Loveland, CO and Karl (Beth) Schultz of Princeton. Also surviving are 11 grand-children, and four great-grandchildren. Surviving as well is one sister Jean Schwingle of Mendota and many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, 2 brothers and 2 sisters, one granddaughter and one son-in-law Bill Costerisan.
