Cordelia passed away on Tuesday, Dec 23, 2008 at Heartland Health Care Center in Henry. She was born on May 15, 1915 in Princeton, IL. to Arthur and Mary Louise (Morton) Norberg. She graduated from Princeton High School in 1933. She received a bachelors degree in Sociology from Knox College in 1937. She married Howard Miles on March 20, 1938 in her parent's home in Princeton. He preceded her in death on March 21, 2007. She worked as a case worker for the Dept. of Human Services in the 1960s. She was also a partner in and worked for the Cherrie Shoppe and Landahls Dept. Store. She was a life long member of the Presbyterian Church in Princeton. She was also a charter member of the P.E.O. Sisterhood, member of the Hardanger Club, was active in her church, and volunteered for the Red Cross. She was the first female elder in the Presbyterian Church.

Cordelia is survived by her three daughters Julie (Birney) Brown of Princeton,

Jane (Will) Griffin of Louisiana, and Jerralee (Manfred) Ernst of New York. Also surviving are 8 grandchildren Bradley Brown of CO, Michelle Scanlon of South Elgin, Pamela McCallum of Aurora, Todd Rossnagel of LA, Eric Rossnagel of TX, Lars Ernst of NY, Andrea Ernst of ME, and Lauren Ernst of CA. Surviving as well are 10 great grandchildren.
