Katy, TX - Daniel Dean Lemus, 41, formerly of Princeton, IL passed away on Monday, October 18, 2021 in Katy Texas at the Memorial Hermann Katy Hospital.

Daniel was born on April 29, 1980 at Perry Memorial Hospital in Princeton, IL to Nanette Wright (now Sterling). Daniel's stepfather, Kevin Sterling, came into his life at the age of 4 and was always "Dad" to Daniel. He was a graduate of Princeton High School, Class of 1999.
