CMSgt Douglas E. Miller (retired), age 57 of Princeton, passed away on Monday, Apr 21, 2008 at his Residence.

Most recently he received his Bachelors Degree in Emergency Management from Jacksonville State University. He was also a member of First United

Methodist Church. Doug was an avid boater and president of the Henry Marina Yacht Club in Henry, IL.

Doug is survived by his two brothers; Dennis (Cindy Creeks) Miller of Zanesville, OH and Andrew (Tina) Miller of Reinersville, OH and two sisters; Deborah (Robert) Gray of Cambridge, OH and Carrie (James) Price of Ashville, OH.
