



Earl Herbolsheimer

Earl Herbolsheimer, 90, of Princeton, IL., passed away on Sunday, July 31, 2016 at Colonial Healthcare.

Mr. Herbolsheimer was born September 4, 1925, in Princeton, IL to Authur and Beulah (Campell) Herbolsheimer. He married Donna McCue on November 5, 1948. They were married for 64 years and spent 34 winters in St. Petersburg Beach, FL.

He joined the U.S. Navy on January 18, 1944 and was discharged on May 12, 1946. He was in submarine service and served in Admiral Lockwood's SUBPAC 222 South Pacific. After the war Earl joined Merchant Marine and traveled the Atlantic and Pacific oceans for two years. He then returned to the family farm.

He was past master and 50 year member of the Princeton Masonic Lodge and was a member of the Sub Vets of WWII and Bureau County Farm Bureau.

He is survived by his son, Glenn Herbolsheimer of Princeton; and daughter, Stephanie (Keith) Dintelmann of Belleville, IL; three grandchildren, Andrew Herbolsheimer of Palm Harbor, FL., Zachary Dintelmann and Paige Dintelmann of Belleville, IL.

He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Donna; daughter, Karen; and brother, Mevlin Herbolsheimer.
