Mr. Schlindwein passed away on Wednesday, May 07, 2008 at his home. He was born on Sep 03, 1918 in Bancroft, Iowa to Edward and Cecelia (Daly) Schlindwein. He graduated from Kewanee High School in 1936. He served in the US Army during WWII. He married Jane Wagner on Sept. 7, 1940 in Kewanee. He and his wife formed the Princeton News Agency and it remained in the family for fifty years. He was also the superintendant for the Bureau Valley Country Club for 25 years. He was an active member of St. Louis Catholic Church. He was a fourth degree Knight of Columbus. He was also a Golden Gloves Boxer. He was an avid golfer and sports fan, especially Notre Dame football.

He is survived by his wife Jane Schlindwein of Princeton. Also surviving are

his 4 children: Phil (Sandy) Schlindwein of FL, Tim (Jill) Schlindwein of Oakbrook, Mary (Art) Poppens of WI, Paul (Teri) Schlindwein of Princeton.
