Mr. Browning passed away on Friday, Dec 06, 2013 at Colonial Rehab and Nursing Center. He was born on Dec 28, 1913 in Annawan, Illinois to William "Pat" Browning and Sue (Boyd) Browning. He attended Annawan Schools and graduated from Western Illinois University, where he played baseball, and received a degree in Education. He married Dorothy Velma Doll on August 5, 1939, she died on August 5, 1990. Glenn began his career as a teacher in a one room school house in Annawan. In 1945 he opened a Ford car dealership in Bradford. He moved the dealership in 1964 to West Peru Street in Princeton. In 1969 he built a new building to house the dealership and the building still stands today. He was a member of First United Methodist Church of Princeton. He was a referee for basketball and was involved with many community organizations and served as the 2004 Grand Marshall of the Homestead Parade.

Glenn is survived by his children; Kay Browning of Princeton and Sarah (David) Butler of St. Louis. Also surviving are three grandchildren; Tim (Robin) Browning of Zionsville, Indiana, Molly Butler of Nashville, Tennessee and Boyd Butler of Boulder, Colorado and three great-grandchildren; Taylor, Alexandra and Maxwell Browning.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, eight siblings, one son Don Browning and one grandson Christopher Browning.
