Mr. Hultine passed away on Monday, Jan 25, 2010 at his home. He was born on Sep 18, 1919 in Berlin Twp near Malden, to Axel and Katherine (Pierson) Hultine. He attended the one room Watson School near Five Points and graduated from Malden High School. He married Hannah June Vroom on November 24, 1946 in Princeton. He worked as a hired hand and was employed by the County Farm before entering the Army Air Corps in 1941. He was on KP duty at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri on December 7, 1941, Pearl Harbor. He farmed for many years and was a part-time truck driver. He was a member of the Princeton American Legion Post and served as commander for 12 years. He also belonged to the Kiwanis and served on the Malden School Board.

He is survived by his wife Hannah June Hultine of Princeton. Also surviving

are three children; Sandra (Pat) Noto of Ottawa, Lynn (Kathy) Hultine of Princeton and June (Gail) Ohlson of Ohio, IL. Surviving as well are 7 grandchildren Laura (Brett) Bruner of Missouri, Anthony (Mary) Noto of CO, Amanda (Aaron) Diers of Indiana, Sarah (David) Massengale of Missouri, David Ohlson of Princeton, Ellen (Jeff) Day of Grenoble, France, and Evan Hultine of Princeton and several great-grandchildren. Also surviving is one brother Carl (Pat) Hultine of Princeton and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one sister Violet, and one brother Robert.
