H. Leroy Reed, age 91 of Princeton, passed away on Thursday, Oct 18, 2007, 12:14 AM at Liberty Village of Princeton. Service will be held at a later date.

He was born on Jun 03, 1916 in Bradford, Illinois to Frank and Maude (Thrum) Reed. He was a 1935 graduate of Bradford High School. He married Alverta R. Quickle on Jan. 19, 1958 in Princeton. She preceded him in death on April 5, 2005.

Leroy farmed in rural Bradford, did plumbing and heating with Fred Lopen, was road commissioner in Milo Township, was a heavy equipment operator for P.D. Strunk and Dick Nelson, was a water treatment operator with Lake Arispie, and finally retired as an operator at the Princeton Power Plant in 1978.

Leroy was a Gold Coat Volunteer at Perry Memorial Hospital, a member of the Elks, a 50 year member of the Ancient Accepted Scotts Rite of Free Masonry, and a volunteer for Meals on Wheels. In addition, he loved fishing, CB radio, and he had his pilot license because he loved to fly.

Leroy is survived by his daughter Mary Ann (Gary Hollocker)Jennings of McNabb, his granddaughter Heather (Tony) Kloster of Normal, and his grandson Ryan Jennings of Normal. He was preceded by his parents, wife and one sister.
