



James John Grundman

October 15, 1927 - April 3, 2023

Princeton - James John Grundman, 95, a longtime resident of Princeton, passed away on Monday, April 3 after a short illness.

Born in Faribault, Minnesota, October 15, 1927, he was the son of Lawrence R. and Ethel (Ray) Grundman. A graduate of Bethlehem Academy, he served in the U.S. Navy during World War II and was stationed in the Pacific. After his honorable discharge, he returned to Minnesota and began a 40-year career at Jostens in the tool and die department, eventually becoming its head and helping to open the Jostens plant in Princeton in 1959.

He married the former Elaine Rustad of Kenyon, Minnesota, on November 12, 1951, and together they had four children. Mrs. Grundman died in 1992. In 1996, he married Bonnie Ryan McGoff and they lived in Owatonna, Minnesota, until her death in 2018, when he returned to Princeton.

He is survived by three of his children: Gail (Dan) Kelly, Jean (Jake) Morrissey, and Steven (Denise) Grundman; eight grandchildren and ten great grandchildren. He was predeceased by both of his wives, his son Thomas, daughter-in-law Carol Lewis Grundman, and his granddaughter Eileen.
