PRINCETON — Jay P. Mickow, 61, of Princeton passed away Tuesday, Feb. 14, 2017, at Perry Memorial Hospital in Princeton.

He was born April 11, 1955, in St. Paul, Minn., to Ralph P. and Barbara (Felcyn) Mickow. He married Mary Coyne Jan. 12, 1980, in Princeton. She survives.
