PRINCETON — John William Schmidt, 89, of 816 N. Church St., Princeton, died Thursday, Jan. 17, 2008, at Orchard View Rehabilitation and Health Care Center in Princeton.

Born Sept. 21, 1918, in Oskaloosa, Iowa, to John H. and Marie (Schultz) Schmidt, he married Verna Belle Merck Nov. 25, 1941, in Ottumwa, Iowa. She survives.

He served in the 7th Army Air Corps during World War II, from 1943 to 1946. He was a bombardier in the South Pacific. He had been employed by Wilson & Co. Meat Packers for 43 years.
