Kailey enjoyed fishing, riding motorcycles, listening to loud music, hikes in the woods, trying out new restaurants, making people laugh, vacations, and coloring. Most importantly she loved spending time with her children, especially swimming with them.

She is survived by her father Doug (Roxy) Piper; mother Rachael "Renee" (Mike Moriarity) Gerard; children Eastyn Ehm, Jaxsyn and Brynleigh Specht; sister Allyssa (Austin) Hewitt; stepsister Misty Stocking; maternal grandmother Ketra Fordham; nieces Emmy Thompson, Kynslee and Hadlie Hewitt, Ahmyrie Peden, and Kennedy Stocking; and numerous aunts, uncles, and cousins.

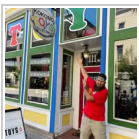
