Leland Puttcamp passed away on Saturday, July 12, 2014 at home in Wheaton, IL where he was surrounded by, and will be missed by, his loving friends and care-givers. He was born June 9, 1919, in Dover Twp, IL to Charles and Louise (Werner) Puttcamp. He graduated from Princeton High School in 1937. Leland married Rita M. Martin in Columbus, OH on May 15, 1943. Leland served four years in the U.S. Air Force during WWII, two and one half years in England and Germany. After the war he worked for over 30 years as a rehabilitation therapist in Veterans Hospitals in Chillicothe, OH and then Hines, IL.

Leland was a private man and a naturalist at heart his whole life. A member of the Audubon Society his grounds were a sanctuary for rare birds and flowers. He also loved studying and writing articles for both historical and genealogical

societies. Leland was a strong advocate and long-time sponsor for the St. Joseph's Lakota Indians School and Missions in Chamberlain, SD.

Leland will be greatly missed by many loving friends.

He was preceded by his parents, his wife Rita, and one son Charles.
