Princeton - Alfred LeVon "Lee" Pence, 90, of Princeton, IL passed away surrounded by his family on January 1, 2023.

Lee was born on June 16, 1932 to the late Alfred Jay and Lucile (Vaughan) Pence in Carmen, IL. He was a graduate of Chillicothe High School, Class of 1950, and Western Illinois University, Class of 1954.

He married Patricia (Keene) Pence on June 7, 1952. They raised four children: Curt, Dave, LeAnn, and Patrick. Patricia died in May 1984; Dave died in February 2002.
