Lloyd L. Simon, 73, Mosinee, died in Elk Grove Village, Illinois on Monday, Sept. 5, 2022.

He was born on Sept. 17, 1948, raised in Illinois, the son of the late Robert and Betty (French) Simon. Lloyd married Barbara Douglas on June 16, 1973. She survives.

Lloyd graduated from Princeton High School in 1966. He was drafted into the military to serve in Vietnam in the Army as a medic until his honorable discharge in 1970.
