Mrs. Earley passed away on Saturday, Feb 25, 2012 at Liberty Village of Princeton. She was born on Feb 25, 1923 in Ohio to Albert and Carrie (Davis) Bachmann. The Bachmanns were a musical family and she and her sisters played the piano and sang in the community, including a talent show performance in Cleveland. Marge graduated from Ashland High School in Ohio. She was a pianist for a square dancing group in Ohio, which is where she met her husband Willard "Bill" Earley. Marge and Bill married on November 2, 1942 in Ashland, Kentucky. Marge first worked as a bookkeeper in Ohio and Texas. Later, she was a farmer right beside her husband and was life-long homemaker. In 1951 they moved to Illinois with Bill's parents and brother and his sister's family in a series of caravans of cars, tractors, trucks, adults, children and assorted animals- back and forth with no cell phones, interstates, fast food, or GPS. She was a prized baker of many things,

especially pies and coffee cake. Marge was also an accomplished pianist and songwriter throughout the greater local community. She was a previous Malden resident and was very active in that community. She enjoyed writing and performing various shows with the Malden Community Club. Marge was also a previous member of the Malden Methodist Church.
