



## Michael Francis Kuhn

June 17, 1949 - June 27, 2025

Princeton - Michael "Mike" Francis Kuhn, 76, of Princeton, IL passed away on Friday, June 27, 2025, in Fairfield, IL. Born on June 17, 1949, at Perry Memorial Hospital in Princeton to Charles "Buck" and Arvilla "Tillie" (Pierson) Kuhn. Mike graduated from Princeton High School, Class of 1967. He was drafted into the U.S. Army on March 3, 1970. He studied at Fort Campbell, KY and Fort Lewis, Washington where he trained as a radio mechanic and repairman.
