PRINCETON – Mildred Marie Piper passed away Monday August 24, 2015 at the age of 97, at Perry Memorial Hospital in Princeton IL. A Funeral Service for Mildred will be held on Friday August 28, 2015 at 11:00 AM at Norberg Memorial Home in Princeton. Pastor Norman Femrite of the First Lutheran Church in Princeton will officiate.
