



Richard Clark Genslinger

January 10, 1934 - April 2, 2024

Princeton - Richard "Dick" C. Genslinger, 90, of Princeton, IL passed away at Aperion Care on Tuesday, April 2, 2024, where he had only recently resided, living all but his last three weeks in his home.

Dick was born on January 10, 1934, to the late Clarence and Marjorie (Howard) Genslinger in Malden, IL. He graduated from Malden High School. He married Joyce Sapp on November 20, 1958, at the First Lutheran Church of Princeton and they celebrated almost 62 years together.

He worked for the Santa Fe Railroad until he retired 25 years ago, was a member of the Wyandot VFW and the Moose Lodge in Princeton and was a familiar face at the Princeton Inn and Park Tavern - if you frequent either establishment be sure to tip a Schlitz in his memory. Dick loved to spend time with his kids, grandkids and great grandkids. Nothing made him happier and smile more. He had fond memories of fishing and hunting with family and friends. He was proud of the time he spent in the Army during the Korean War and told great stories about that experience. He enjoyed gardening, cooking and keeping his house up and did so until he became too ill. His presence will be sorely missed by his neighbors who often stopped over to chat or bring him treats as he sat in his garage rocking chair listening to Willie's Roadhouse on his radio, waving to people out for walks and kids riding bikes, and drinking his favorite beverage (the afore-mentioned Schlitz).
