PRINCETON – Robert 'Bob' Clifford Aaron, age 87, passed away on Thursday, August 6, 2015 at Liberty Village in Princeton, IL. Bob married Helen Earley in Dixon IL on January 24, 1963. They were married for 52 years. Bob enjoyed his time off building elaborate model train sets and scenery. He was an Antique Car collector and was especially fond of his 1958 Edsel. Bob was a longtime member of the Farm Bureau.
