PRINCETON — Robert Francis Joiner, 96, of Princeton passed away Tuesday, Sept. 8, 2015, at Liberty Village in Princeton.

He was born Dec. 30, 1918, in Albia, Iowa, a son of Clayton and Iona (Strunk) Joiner. He lived in various locations in Iowa and Illinois as a child until the family settled in Tiskilwa. He served in the U.S. Air Force Signal Corps and met his wife in Nebo, Ill., while stationed at a military base near St. Louis, Mo.

Robert married June (Yocum) Joiner in Centerville, Iowa, on Dec. 29, 1940, just prior to his service for our country in England during World War II. Upon his return from the war, they settled in Tiskilwa.

Robert worked his entire life for Strunk Brothers Road Construction Company and was a superintendent on several interstate highways in Illinois. In 1979, he and his wife retired to Green Valley, Ariz. After her death in January 2009, Robert moved back to Princeton.

He was preceded in death by his wife, June; his parents; two brothers, Hobart

and Max; and two sisters, Maxine and Barbara.

His survivors are his sisters, Nadine Sapp of Princeton, Charlotte Morris of Yorkville and Susan Leverett of Valrico, Fla.; his brothers, William of Princeton, Tom of Utica, Ted of Tiskilwa, Jerry of Cherry and Joe of Seymour, Ind.; and numerous nieces and nephews.

There will be no visitation or funeral service, but there will be a graveside service in Nebo, Ill., where he will be buried with his wife at a later date.
