March 27, 1926 - December 5, 2020

Princeton - Robert E. Levitt "Bob" was 94 born in Effingham, IL. He was the son of Mary (Harris) and Roy Levitt. Bob was a devoted Husband, loving Father, Grandfather and Great-Grandfather. Bob passed away at 10:30 p.m. on Saturday, December 5, 2020 as a patient of Vitas Hospice, at Liberty Village in Princeton, IL among caring nurses and aides.

Bob attended a Parochial School then at age 16, he joined the Navy as a Fireman First Class during World War II. He was honorably discharged in 1946. Bob married the love of his life, Jeannine L. (Casper) Levitt, on October 11, 1947 in Kankakee, IL. They were happily married for almost 54 yrs.

He was a butcher by trade at grocery stores, Walnut Locker and Wyonet Locker. Bob and Jeannine owned a small grocery/grill in Princeton. They were members of St. Louis Catholic Church, where Bob especially enjoyed being their school custodian. He touched the hearts of many children (and adults) playing the Easter Bunny, Santa at movies, Liberty Village and especially at his son, Father Don's, masses. Bob loved to bowl and lived to play golf with friends and family, (making at least 2 hole-in-ones). He actually did virtual golf arranged by Vitas Hospice at age 92. He was an avid football and baseball fan.
