PRINCETON — Roy L. McKune, 86, of Princeton, passed away Saturday, Sept. 17, 2016, at the LaSalle Veterans Home in LaSalle.

Born June 15, 1930, in Princeton to Charles Marion and Anna M. (Bastaian) McKune, he married Myrna K. Heuer Nov. 10, 1956, in the United Bretheren Church in Manlius. She preceded him in death on Aug. 13, 2011.

He served in the U.S. Navy for over five years and was a Korean War veteran. He had been employed as a postmaster for the U.S. government, by the Bureau County Republican, and by Primeway grocery store and The Presbyterian shopping service.

He was a member of the Elks Lodge and the Presbyterian church, where he served as a deacon, starting in 1961, for many years. He enjoyed telling jokes, studying Illinois American history, coffee with friends, and collecting stamps and coins.

Surviving are one daughter, Michelle A. McKune; two sons, Martin (Erfen Gonzalez) McKune of Chicago and Michael (Kelly Davis) McKune of Princeton; one sisters, Marjorie Reynolds; three grandchildren, Julie and Tara Griffiths, and Arzella McKune; and one great-grandchild, Brianna Griffiths.

He was also preceded in death by his parents; one brother, Charles; and one sister, Muriel.

Services will be at 6 p.m. Wednesday, Sept. 21, at the Norberg Memorial Home, Princeton, with visitation from 4 to 6 p.m. Burial will be at 11 a.m. Thursday, Sept. 22, in Elm Lawn Memorial Park in Princeton with military services conducted by the Princeton Veterans Group Honor Guard.
