Stella Comerford Eiler, Pana Native, Dies in Princeton

Graveside funeral services for Stella Opal Comerford Eiler, 94 of Princeton, a native of Pana, were held today, Monday, Feb. 4, in Greenwood Cemetery, Bureau, with Rev. Jon Olinger officiating. All services were private and there was no visitation.

Mrs. Eiler died Thursday, Jan. 31, 2013 in Perry Memorial Hospital, Princeton. She was born Oct. 26, 1918 in Pana, the daughter of Phillip Comerford and Rosa Eck Comerford. She married Homer Eiler on Feb. 4, 1938 in Clinton, Iowa. He died May 8, 2012.

Opal was a farm wife and ran Opal's Beauty Shop in Princeton for 20 years. She and her husband also operated the Avalon Club in Princeton for many years. She was a member of the Bureau County Farm Bureau and the Bureau County Taxpayers Association. She enjoyed tending to and buying the animals on their farm.
