Princeton - Vera "Marilyn" Nelson, 102 years and 233 days, passed away on Thursday, October 13, 2022 at Liberty Village. Surrounded by her loving family who saw her safety onto her next adventure.

Marilyn, as she was known by everyone who knew her, was born on February 22, 1920, to the late John and Nettie (Turnbull) Krapff. She was born in her grandparents' home on Euclid Avenue, directly across the street from where Princeton High School stands now.

She was a graduate of Ohio High School, Class of 1937. She married the late Robert Nelson in Iowa on August 17, 1940. They celebrated their 75th wedding anniversary before Roberts passing in 2016.

Marilyn spent most of her life as a farmer's wife, that meant everything from chief cook and bottle washer, doctor, tractor driver or whatever was required, everyone did their part. Later in life she worked at Perry Memorial Hospital and Hornsby's. She was a member of the First Lutheran Church of Princeton.
