Vivian A. May, age 93, of Princeton, IL passed away on Tuesday, February 12, 2013 at Perry Memorial Hospital, in Princeton, IL . Born on October 14, 1919 in rural Tiskilwa, IL, she was the daughter of Earl and Eathel (Elliot) Miller. She graduated from Princeton High School in 1937. She was a life long homemaker and also worked at Harper-Wyman, retiring after 26 years. On Sep 30, 1939, she married Glenn May in Princeton, Illinois. He died on March 26, 1969.
