Princeton - William H Johnson (Bill), 66, passed away on Saturday, November 9, 2019 after a lengthy fight with ALS.

Bill was born on July 14, 1953, the son of Robert E and Joann (Corwin) Johnson. He graduated from Princeton High School and then with honors from the University of Illinois.

Bill was married to Jackie on June 4, 1977; they were married 42 years.
